Fr Liborio's Reflection

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

In today's Gospel the Pharisees try to entrap Jesus with an either/or question – it's a question that sets up a no win scenario (i.e. "Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?"). However, Jesus is able to respond beyond their imagining. Jesus sees through their plot to entrap Him and in giving the perfect response He is able to move the conversation to focus on their hypocrisy.

Now-a-days there is evidence of hypocrisy everywhere (even in the Church by its members who lead it... and here I need to look at myself in the mirror I know) – you just need to watch CNN, FOX, CBC, etc., or read newspapers like The New York Times, The Toronto Sun, The National Post, etc., and you will see the hypocrisy that is being thrown about like the stones that were thrown at a stoning in the time of Jesus. These hypocrisies can malign and ruin a person's career or good name, it can damage a business or charitable organization, it can create lies from Truth and malign a person's faith. Yes, hypocrites throw stones and do not count the cost of the damage they do.

We can get caught up in throwing our own stones at people – we can say things and do things that can sound so moral or just, but live to the contrary.

Let us ask our Lord to help us live and act as He did and not like the Pharisees of his time.


Kids Pick of the Week



St. Mary's will be participating in this year's 40 days for life on **October 18th**.

Join us and spend an hour, or more, anytime between 7:00am and 7:00pm at the **vigil site**, located just west of Trillium Hospital (Queensway location) on the southside of Queensway (across from abortion center located at **101 Queensway**).

You can go directly to the site, or go first to St. Catherine of Siena Church to park, sign-in and get 40 Days for Life signs. They do have a limited quantity of masks and hand sanitizer (bring your own supplies if possible to reduce their supplies costs).

6 Ways to Be a Better Listener at Home

Improve communication with your kids



In the midst of busy family life, it can be easy to overlook one of a parent's most effective tools for communicating respect to our children: **the art of listening well.**

Here are a few suggestions that you can put to work immediately:

1. Look your children in the eye when they are talking to you.
2. Repeat without judgment what they've said.
3. Hold your tongue.
4. Ask open-ended questions (without judgment).
5. Share your experience and values rather than just your advice.
6. Pray.
