Fr Liborio's Reflection

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

In Today's Gospel Jesus shows us a scenario which is often lived out in our family lives. Jesus invites us to consider in this scenario if we do the WILL of our Heavenly Father, or if we only say we will but in fact never do?

How many times have parents heard their children say 'yes, I will clean my room', but never do. Or how many times are parents surprised when a child says 'no, I will not clean my room', but later changes their minds and does it. Yes, this scenario is lived out in many ways in our world we live in - in family dynamics and in workplaces. How we respond to our Heavenly Father's requests is an important one, because as the Gospel tells us, it is a matter of Eternal Life lived with the Father.

Jesus makes it clear that we need to do the Will of the Father, because He is not only our Father, but also because He knows what is best for us.

Here is the Gospel below. I invite you to reflect on it this week and ask yourself if you are doing the WILL of the Father.

Jesus said to the chief priests and elders of the people:
 "What is your opinion?
 A man had two sons.
 He came to the first and said,
 'Son, go out and work in the vineyard today. 'He said in reply, 'I will not, ' but afterwards changed his mind and went.
 The man came to the other son and gave the same order.
 He said in reply, 'Yes, sir, 'but did not go.

Which of the two did his father's will?"
 They answered, "The first."
 Jesus said to them, "Amen, I say to you, tax collectors and prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God before you.
 When John came to you in the way of righteousness, you did not believe him; but tax collectors and prostitutes did. Yet even when you saw that, you did not later change your minds and believe him."
