Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Pastors' Corner:



Last week's pastor's corner focused on "Who is Jesus Christ?" and how this question is raised in our first week of six in our new Baptismal preparation process. The second theme we also look at on the first session is the Catholic Church and how it relates to Jesus Christ.

If we were to ask strangers on a busy street corner what they thought of the Catholic Church, we would get a lot of responses in the negative, I would suspect. To separate the Catholic Church from Jesus Christ is an easy thing for people to

do now-a-days. People are comfortable in making the separation... even Catholics. Cardinal Dolan (Archdiocese of New York) recently spoke to this issue of how Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church are being separated – as if one can live on without the other. A report was written making mention of some of Cardinal Dolan's key points in his presentation. Here are these key points:

Speaking of those who believe there is a separation "Their favorite caricature of the church is as a corrupt, arrogant, self-righteous, judgmental hypocrite," Dolan said. "I sure don't have any problem admitting that, at times, it can be tough to love the church because of her imperfections. The mystical body of Christ has lots of warts."

However, Dolan noted, it is clear from the Acts of the Apostles, in particular the conversion of St. Paul, that "Jesus Christ and his church are inseparable."

When Saul was blinded and knocked off his horse on his way to Damascus, Dolan said, the voice he heard was, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?"

"He didn't say, 'Why do you persecute my people?' Nope. 'My followers?' Nope. 'My disciples?' Nope. To be rather blunt, Jesus and his church are the same. Christ and his church are one. Jesus Christ and his church are synonymous," the cardinal continued.

"The dominant opinion and sentiment that we face

today is, 'We want Christ; we want nothing to do with that stupid church.'"
A YouTube video by evangelical Jefferson Bethke - "Why I hate religion but love Jesus" - "went viral with 27 million views" because of that sentiment, he said. "Such is the popular and the successful crusade now to annul the spousal bond between Christ and his bride, the church," Dolan said. "We hear this all the time, right? 'I prefer spirituality to religion; I want the Lord as my shepherd, as long as I'm the only one there; I want Christ as my king in a kingdom of one; I'll believe, I won't belong; God is my father, and I'm the only child; Jesus is my general, but there's no army.' They want Christ without his church.

It is clear from Church teaching and History that Jesus Christ decided to Found a CHURCH... the Catholic Church. He gave St. Peter the Keys to this Church and made him His Vicar on Earth. Yes, it has its flaws (it's warts, as Cardinal Dolan says) and this is because its members are flawed and sinful. And yet, Christ sticks with his Church, because he gave his life on the cross for its birth... and he has married it in a mystical union.

In the first session of our new Baptism preparation process we try to remind the parents that the baptism of their child we be an entrance (and integration) into the Body of Christ which is the Church. We hope that by focusing on the importance of knowing Christ and His Church he founded, they can see the importance of "Practicing their Faith" so that they can raise their children in the "Practice of the Faith".

We will be blessing our parish Advent wreath and lighting the first purple candle the weekend of **December 2 & 3** (First Sunday of Advent).


Families are invited to bring their Christmas Advent Wreath on that weekend to have it blessed at any of the Masses.
