Call for Conscience Campaign

With physician-assisted suicide now legal in Canada, healthcare practitioners and facilities in some provinces are in a compromised position. Those who cannot support assisted suicide or euthanasia because of their conscience, faith, or commitment to the Hippocratic Oath, are forced to compromise their convictions. This is wrong. We need your help now to ensure Canadians' faith and conscience rights are protected.

The **CALL FOR CONSCIENCE CAMPAIGN** is being organized by the Coalition for HealthCARE and Conscience. It is supported by the Assembly of Catholic Bishops of Ontario. The focus of the campaign is to encourage Ontario's political parties to:

- Provide conscience protection for doctors, nurses, pharmacists and other health professionals who do not want to participate in assisted suicide or euthanasia. Currently, Ontario's regulatory agencies are forcing referral, even if this is contrary to the caregiver's convictions. Caregivers are at risk of being disciplined and losing their license to practice.
- Support faith-based hospitals, hospices, and nursing homes who do not allow assisted suicide or euthanasia on the premises.
- Ensure sufficient palliative care in the province.
