Pastor's Corner as We Begin Lent

his weekend we have entered into the Lenten season. This is a time where you and I are called to take time to reflect on how our faith life is going.

Once a year, many people perform their annual cleaning (i.e. "spring cleaning") around their home and take stock of what they have accumulated that can and should be thrown out. During this cleaning, cobwebs are removed, unused clothing discarded and repairs are made. We can say that Lent is a form of "spring cleaning". We are called, through the disciplines of Fasting, Almsgiving and Prayer (i.e. the Three Pillars of Lent), to grow in our faith.

During Lent we are called to discard any clothing (possessions) that do not allow us to focus on what we most need – if you are caught up with material possessions and not on the ONE who provides everything for us, then use the discipline of "Fasting" to refocus yourself on the ONE whom you need to have in your life.

During Lent we are called to repair the areas of our life where we caused damage by our sinfulness – if you have been thinking of yourself before others (i.e. this is when sin rears its ugly head), then use the discipline of "Almsgiving" to think of others and their needs.

During Lent we are called to remove the cobwebs that have formed around our prayer life – if your prayer life has dried up, then use the discipline of "Prayer" to deepen your relationship with the God who created you and made you for Himself.

Let us not let this time of "spiritual cleaning" pass us by without taking action where there is need to do so.

You will all be in my prayers and I ask that you please pray for me as well. May we all have a fulfilling and successful "Spiritual Lenten Cleaning". **Blessings, Fr. Liborio**

My dear friends,

Thank you for all that you currently do to support and strengthen our Catholic community. Please keep me in your prayers as I do all of you.

It is troubling that, with increasing frequency, our faith community faces significant challenges in the public square. Two recent examples are the lack of conscience protection for health care workers who are asked to participate in assisted suicide and the federal government's insistence that faith groups disavow their key values in order to receive Canada Summer Jobs grants. It is important that we are educated on such issues and that our voices are heard in response.

Periodically, I would like to contact you directly or through a trusted faith partner to share information in a timely manner on issues such as health care, education and religious freedom. For this reason, I encourage you to participate in a "Sign-Up Sunday" being held in your parish and across the Archdiocese of Toronto.

I ask all parishioners to provide their name, postal code and email address on lists available at parishes on designated weekends in late February and early March. Anticipating a provincial election this June, we will begin with an awareness campaign around conscience rights related to assisted suicide/euthanasia. In 2017, more than 30,000 letters were sent to local Members of Provincial Parliament. The 2018 Call for Conscience campaign has the following goals:

- 1) to renew the call to protect the right of health care professionals to abstain from any involvement in causing the death of their patients;
- 2) to provide protection for faith-based facilities that do not wish to participate in assisted suicide/euthanasia; and
- 3) to ask elected Members of Provincial Parliament (MPPs) and those seeking office to increase access and funding for palliative care in Ontario.

When you provide your personal information, be assured it will be kept confidential and you can unsubscribe from the program at any time. You will only receive an email from me or groups I trust on these important issues. Initially, you will receive an email from the Coalition for HealthCARE and Conscience, providig a link to contact candidates in your riding and the leaders of our provincial parties to respectfully express your concern. The whole process, done electronically, takes only five minutes. If you do not have an email account, draft letters will be available to send to your MPP.

I hope that you will assist me by participating in "Sign-Up Sunday". It is critical that we use modern technology to communicate effectively, ensuring our voice is heard in the public square. Please join me as we pray for all those suffering and for those entrusted to care for them.
