uffering and Cross bring new life Jesus spent forty days tested in the desert, and the Church invites us to enter into a season of penance and self-discipline. We must come to terms with our passions- that is, those unruly inclinations and emotions that create, jealousy. intemperance, and lust. We often like to be rewarded for our efforts. we exercise to stay fit and we diet to lose weight. If these do not achieve our goal, we are frustrated. The disciplines of the spiritual life prayer, fasting, and good works - have a reward, too. This reward might be a deeper relationship with God, greater clarity of mind, or an appreciation for the poor. These practices exercise our minds and body to be in a more self-controlled manner.

How much some athletes, famous rock and movie stars, politicians, even ourselves sacrifice to achieve glorification in this world, that is, in the end, short-lived.

This sacrifice and glorification is self-serving. Jesus invites another kind of sacrifice and glorification that ultimately different, Jesus teaches us that what leads to glorification is dying to self, losing our lives, serving him and others. He has shown us the way by being -lifted up from the earth.

For example, parents giving time and energy to help their children grow; employees speaking the truth even when there is personal cost; neighbors responding to the needs of the poor. The glorification we receive for being other-centered is given to us even now in the joy that comes from deepened relationships, from seeing the relief and gratitude of others, from our own satisfaction for having acted like Jesus. In such faithful discipleship. we grow toward the ultimate glorification of eternal Life.

In All - No pain, No gain! The essence of discipleship is that we stand with Jesus and align our own identity with his, accept self-denial and self-giving, and in this way walk with him to the cross. Disciples go wherever the Master goes. Fr Gustavo


