

Pastor's Corner - Finally, we have our New Parish Hall!!!!



Well it's a reality and no longer a "dream" for many of our parishioners, who have waited and longed for our own "Parish Hall". May this wonderful addition to our parish, be used for the glory of God. In keeping with my desire to be as transparent as I can with you (who as parishioners, have given financially to the construction of this new hall), I plan in the next month or so to provide you with a document that will outline the full cost of this project from beginning to end. It is your right to know where your money has gone and the debt we will have at the end of this building project. Yes, our parish will have a debt that we will need to

pay back to the Archdiocese (who has loaned us the money). I hope to share with you our financial plan to eliminate this debt in a timely manor. Having a parish hall now opens us up to questions that did not exist prior to its construction. You might be wondering if we will be renting the space out for Weddings, Baptisms, First Communions, Confirmations, Anniversary celebrations, etc. To address these questions and many more, I formed a Hall Committee about three months ago to come up with policies and procedures for the use of "our" new parish hall. This committee was formed of about 10-15 parishioners – some representing groups like the CWL and KofC. This committee worked hard to form the first working draft of our parish hall's policies and procedures. I am sure that this working draft will need to be amended as we begin to use the parish hall and encounter issues the committee did not think of.

As of this moment our plan is not to rent out our parish hall for "private use" (even of parishioners). We have decided not to rent the hall for private function because it eliminates our parish from using it ourselves. Take for example the case of a wedding reception — a couple requesting the use of our hall for their wedding reception most often need to book it about a year in advance. This would mean that a year later, if the parish wanted to bring in a speaker to talk on a specific topic (and he/she were only available on the weekend of a "booked wedding reception") then the parish hall would no longer be available for parish use. Or imagine if you will, that on that specific weekend (that the wedding was booked), the Maple Leafs were playing the 7th game of the Stanley Cup, we would not be able to have a community "Leaf Nation" gathering in the hall, because of the wedding. I hope that these two simple examples clarifies our reasons for keeping the parish hall for "our" use and not for private functions. After all this is why we built the hall in the first place (i.e. that it can be for the use of our parish family).

The only exception we will make will be in the area of funeral receptions – these are held in the late mornings and/or early afternoons and only require two to three days notice. We have been in contact with Wards Funeral home, as well as Scotts Funeral home and we have come up with wonderful ways to work together so that families can use our space to meet and share in fellowship after a death of a loved one, and the parish will in turn receive much needed financial compensation to maintain the upkeep of this new parish hall.

So until this information comes out, I invite you to enjoy the new space and think of getting involved in the various groups of our parish and/or come out to the numerous talks and presentations we will be offering throughout the coming years.

Yes, let us pray that "OUR" new parish hall will be used for the Glory of God. Blessings, Fr. Liborio

P.s. We have also come up with the wonderful names for the three dividing halls that make up "St. Mary's Hall". The names will be: "Our Lady of Fatima", "Our Lady of Lourdes" and "Our Lady of Guadeloupe". These three Marian titles all refer us back to "St. Mary" - I think these names are fantastic and I thank those who suggested it to me.


