# Pastor's Corner

his weekend, Doug Asselstine, was Ordained to the Permanent Deaconate. In a packed Cathedral Cardinal Collins ordained Deacon Doug (that sounds so nice, doesn't it?) and nine other men to the diaconal service in the Archdiocese of Toronto. Deacon Doug's main ministry will be at a nursing home, where he will be able to meet our elderly brothers and sisters and strengthen them in this later stage of their life. Deacon Doug will also help us out here at the parish when his time allows him. He will be able to preach, baptize, officiate at weddings and visit the sick to give them communion. But all of this will need to be done with the advice and support of his wife Penny. When a man is starting the Diaconate training, he is reminded of the order of priorities that will enable him to have a health life. As a Deacon the first priority is his family – in this case

Penny and his children and grandchildren are number one in his life. A deacon's second priority is his work – he needs to give to his job as he had been doing before ordination. Finally, the third priority is his diaconal ministry. Penny needs to remind her husband, Deacon Doug, of this order of priorities so that he can have a fulfilling life as husband, worker and deacon. Let's pray for Deacon Doug as he begins his ministry of service to the Church. Below are some words found in the Ordination Rite of a Permanent Deacon.

Deacon Doug, welcome aboard... and now get to work (so that I can take some time off... hahaha).

# Rite of Ordination to the Permanent Deaconate:

After a short homily on the readings of the mass, the bishop uses these words or similar ones and addresses those present:

"This man, your relative and friend, is now to be raised to the order of deacons. Consider carefully the ministry to which he is to be promoted.

He will draw new strength from the gift of the Holy Spirit. He will help the bishop and his body of priests as a minister of the word, of the altar, and of charity. He will make himself a servant of all. As a minister of the altar he will proclaim the Gospel, prepare the sacrifice, and give the Lord's body and blood to the community of believers. It will also be his duty, at the bishop's discretion, to bring God's word to believer and unbeliever alike, to preside over public prayer, to baptize, to assist at marriages and bless them, to give viaticum to the dying, and to lead the rites of burial. Once he is consecrated by the laying on of hands that comes to us from the apostles and is bound more closely to the altar, he will perform works of charity in the name of the bishop or the pastor. From the way he goes about these duties, may you recognize him as a disciple of Jesus, who came to serve, not to be served.

# He then addresses the candidate:

My son, you are being raised to the order of deacons. The Lord has set an example for you to follow.

As a deacon you will serve Jesus Christ, who was known among his disciples as the one who served others. Do the will of God generously. Serve God and mankind in love and joy. Look upon all unchastity and avarice as worship of false gods; for no man can serve two masters. Like the men the apostles chose for works of charity, you should be a man of good reputation, filled with wisdom and the Holy Spirit. Show before God and mankind that you are above every suspicion of blame, a true minister of Christ and of God's mysteries, a man firmly rooted in faith. Never turn away from the hope which the Gospel offers; now you must not only listen to God's word but also preach it. Hold the mystery of faith with a clear conscience. Express in action what you proclaim by word of mouth. Then the people of Christ, brought to life by the Spirit, will be an offering God accepts. Finally, on the last day, when you go to meet the Lord, you will hear him say: "Well done, good and faithful servant, enter into the joy of your Lord."
