Humanitarian Relief

Humanitarian Relief –Indonesia & Philippines Areas of the Philippines were devastated by Typhoon Mangkhut on September 15. Days later, on September 28, an earthquake off the coast of Sulawesi island, Indonesia, caused a tsunami with waves six meters high. To date, more than 1300 people have been confirmed dead and many, many more remain missing. Survivors are struggling to find food and drinkable water. People also need adequate shelter and medical support. The earthquake damaged roads and telecommunications systems, creating many challenges to sending assistance to the affected areas.

The Archdiocese of Toronto is accepting funds that will be sent through Caritas Internationalis, the official relief network of the Vatican. Contributions can be made through our parishes and through the Archdiocese of Toronto online portal at www.archtoronto.org.

In both countries, Caritas agencies have deployed workers to provide food, drinking water, temporary shelter and medical support.
