Pastor's Corner

ear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
This weekend we celebrate the 100th Anniversary since we were first designated as a "Parish". In 1918 the Diocese of Toronto formally established our church as a Parish and with this designation started the journey of a faith community that has now included all of our faith journeys.

During these last 100 years there have been many events that have impacted this parish - local, national and worldwide.

Locally, our City of Brampton has grown from a small community to a real mega-city (and we know this, because it takes some of us one hour or so to get across the city:). Main Street is no longer a gravel road with horse and buggy traversing the farmlands. The "four corners" is no longer the only hub of activity on Saturday evenings. and immigrants are no longer strange sightings.

Nationally, we have become a true nation where we don't always get a cold when the United States sneezes. We have come to understand the importance of multiculturalism. In the mega-cities we have become a United Nations reality. And until now we have lived in

a country where we are free to live our faith without the fear of reprisals.

In these 100 years the World has experienced two World Wars, a man walking on the moon and the wonderful technology of Face Timing family members thousands of kilometers away.

Our Parish has seen pastors, associates and deacons come and go. We have seen linguistic communities (i.e. Portuguese and Spanish) rise. We have journeyed together in the critical moments of our lives (births, weddings and deaths) – and at these critical moments the Church's Sacraments have been celebrated.

But in all that has happened within and outside of our Parish, we have remained consistent in our "Faith" - we have not compromised our belief that Jesus Christ is Lord. And we believe all of the faith-filled parishioners of these past 100 years will be together forever in the One family of Christ.
