Pastor's Corner

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ
God is good all the time, and all the time
As we continue experiencing the joy of Easter, I wish you all again a very Happy Easter season.

Some of you might be familiar with a well-known modern musician who once sang, 'love needs confession'! What value has an unconfessed love? Seemingly none! Of course, it does happen at times that, someone falls in love with another but has no clue how to go about expressing it. The contrary is what happened in the Gospel of this weekend. It is not the lover confessing love to the beloved, it is the other way round! First and foremost, St. Peter loved Jesus a lot, this is why before the passion he indirectly confessed this love when he said to Jesus, "I will lay down my life for you" (John 13:37). Nonetheless, after his resurrection Jesus, already was fully aware (for He is God) that St. Peter loved him, did not only do what was extraordinary, but he also did what is contrary to the normal logic (No wonder the Gospel tells us that "Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time 'Do you love me'", John 21:17). For Jesus asked Peter to publicly confess his love for him; in other words, to confess that weak love which could not stand the test of public query, that trembling love which denied its Beloved, that selfish love which preferred its own life to that of the Beloved. But, on the other hand, one might also ask, "What did Jesus need Peter's love for?" Good question! Reading down the passage, one realizes that Jesus wanted to entrust Peter with a huge responsibility, namely to shepherd the flock which He had gathered and redeemed with His own sweat and blood.

Accordingly, Jesus wanted to be sure that his labour would not be in vain. In fact, he waited till He had shown himself thrice to Peter and to the Apostles, clearing therewith every doubt and fear from their minds and hearts. Thus it was not Jesus who needed Peter's love. It was rather Peter himself, who needed to be loved. It was he whose love needed perfection.

Peter needed to be strengthened to carry his own cross! Therefore, after entrusting Peter with the responsibility of shepherding his flock, Jesus asked him to follow Him (cf. John 13:19). And, guess what? This petrine followership has continued since Peter, the first Vicar of Christ on earth (cf. Matt 9:16), all the way to Francis, the 266th Pope. Isn't that amazing? Love can do wonders, yes, but on three condition: love has to be true! It has to be solid! It has to be confessed!

I therefore wish you and your family to spring forth joyfully and to courageously confess your love for Jesus, especially now that we begin our march for the most precious gift: LIFE! Blessings,
