ear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
This weekend we celebrate "Motherhood" and this
motherhood can be understood in its multilayered
expression of love.

We all have our physical mothers who said yes to the gift of "LIFE" in their wombs. These mothers of ours experienced possible mood

swings and morning sicknesses, etc., they said yes to us. So, for all our mothers who gave us life let us say a prayer this day and ask the Lord to be gracious to them – to those who are still living, may God give them peace, comfort and joy in their years and to those mothers who have passed away, may God grant them eternal peace where we hope to one day see them again in the love of God's presence.

We also know that there are mothers who have taken on the role of motherhood through adoption or through marriage. We should not forget these wonderful spiritual mothers.

Lastly, let us remember the two Mothers who are always present to us and strengthens us – Our Mother the Church and Mary, the Mother of God and our Mother.
