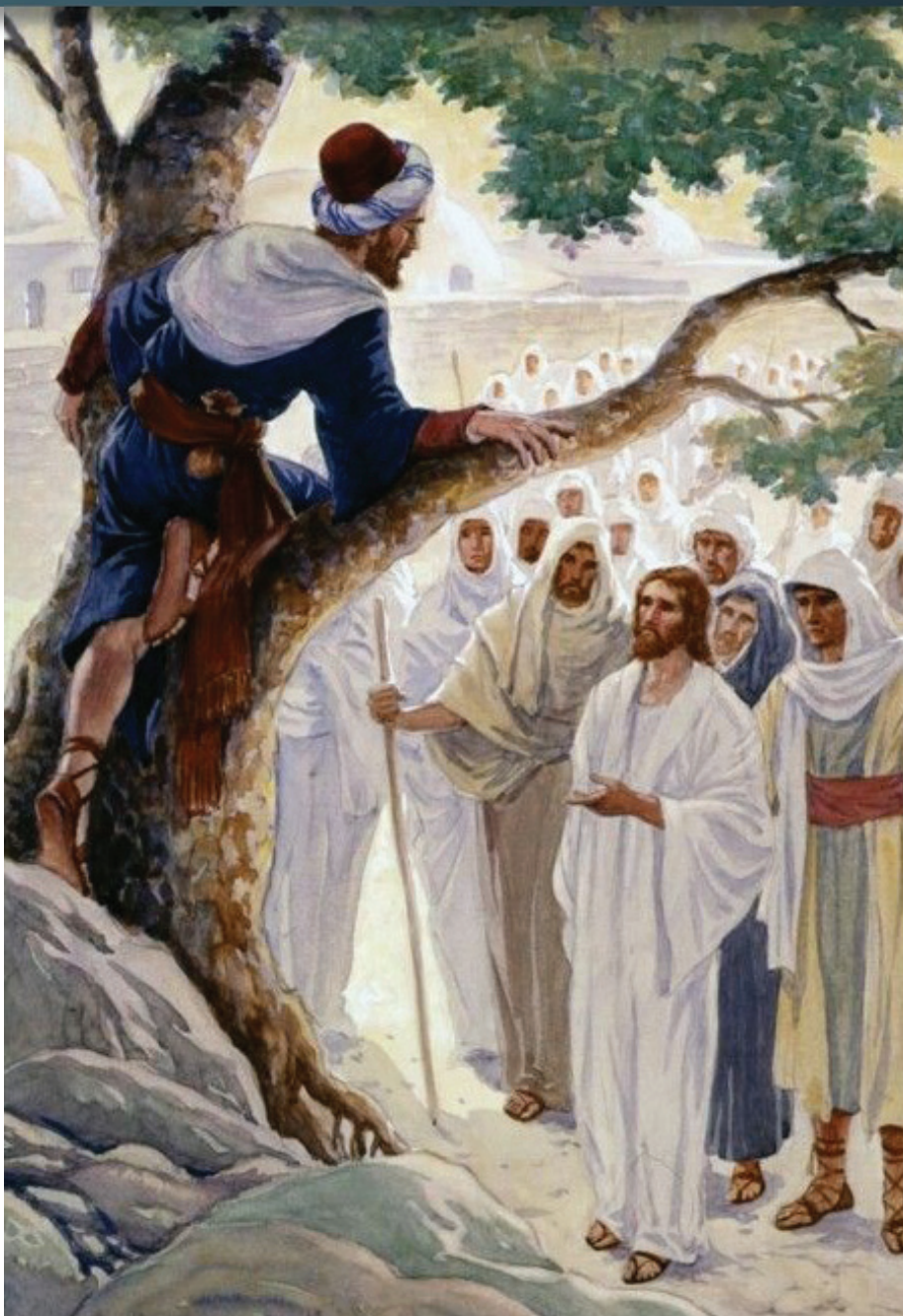

St. Mary's Family Christmas Project - Be a Sponsor Nov. 16th/17th



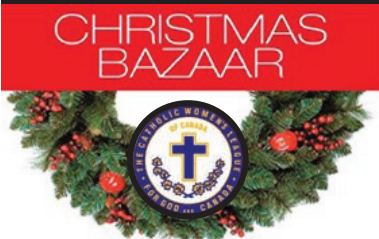
