ADVENT Day of Confessions December 15th - to 21st

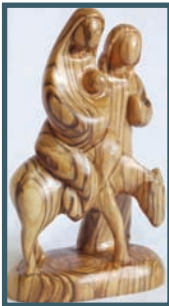
