

## Pastor's Corner

ear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are a people who like to know what others think of in the vast array of topics. One such topic is people's faith life.

And so it is natural to expect that there would be many surveys conducted to see where Catholics are at, regarding many of the dogmas and doctrines we hold as 'Truth' in our Catholic Church. These surveys can be very helpful to Church leaders, such as myself, because they give us a perspective of where people are at in their Catholic faith life. One survey that is very revealing shows the understanding that Catholics have regarding the Blessed Sacrament/Eucharist (i.e. the Bread and Wine Consecrated at Mass). Increasingly Catholics see the Eucharist as a 'Symbol' of Christ's presence. A majority of Catholics understand the Eucharist in the same way that our brothers and sisters in the other Christian traditions understand it (i.e. Anglicans, Methodists, Lutherans, etc.). The number of surveys that have recently been conducted, show clearly that many Catholics do not believe or fully understand what the Catholic Church has taught from the very beginning – what we call in theological language 'Transubstantiation'. For 2000 years the Catholic Church has always taught that the bread and wine offered at Mass, become the true Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Church has taught that the Eucharist is truly Christ present, not in a Symbolic way, but truly present as He is in Heaven.

We need to ask the difficult question why so many Catholics no longer believe or hold to the true teaching on the Eucharist. Why is it that many see the Eucharist as symbol and not as the True Presence? We need to ask this question, because it has many implications on how we see the Church, the Celebration of the Eucharist, the Priesthood, the Authority of the Church, etc.

How do you understand the Eucharist?

Next weekend I will continue to write on this very important distinction.


