### Back to Normal

**We are returning to our normal Sunday liturgies** starting next weekend (Sat. Mar. 05<sup>th</sup>, and Sun. Mar. 06<sup>th</sup>). Our Sunday Liturgies will now return to as it was before the pandemic. This includes but is not limited to:

- Congregational Singing can resume – hopefully with full voice. Yes, let us sing to the Lord!
- We will resume the offertory collection and the bringing up of the offertory gifts (bread and wine) to the Altar.
- People are now able to enter the church through any church entrance as before. You do not need to enter through the main entrance (as has been the case for the last two years).

**Masks must continue to be worn at all times**, while inside the church and hall/meeting rooms.

**Communion on the tongue**, is still suspended until our Archbishop gives us authority to resume this important practice of receiving our Blessed Lord.

**Liturgical ministers** who have not yet returned to active ministry and wish to do so again, are asked to reach out to your liturgical coordinators so that they can add you to the liturgical schedules.

**Groups and Organizations** will be able to resume their gathering/meetings as before. We invite group leaders to reach out to the parish office to request meeting room allocations.

**6:30pm Saturday Mass** is being eliminated effective immediately.

**Our Blessed Sacrament Chapel** is being reinstated as of next Monday, Mar. 07<sup>th</sup>. It will be opened for adoration from **9:30am to 8pm every day during the week** (Monday to Friday) and on **Saturday's from 9:30am to 4pm**.

**We will be winding down our Live-streaming** on Sundays in the next week or two. We are aware that there will be some parishioners who will not be able to come to Sunday Mass due to age and/or ill-health. **We invite those who are not able to attend Sunday Mass to reach out to our parish office – we will be able to provide you a private link so that you can continue to watch our Sunday 11am Mass.**




## St. Kizito The Youngest Martyr

Saint Kizito is the youngest of the group of 22 martyrs of Uganda, beatified by Benedict XV on June 6, 1920 and canonized by Pope Paul VI in Rome on October 18, 1964.

"Kizito, born in 1873 in Uganda, became a page in King Mwanga's court. Joseph Mukassa, the head of the pages, had received the teaching of the White Father Missionaries, Father Lourdel and Father Livinhac. It was Joseph Mukassa who secretly taught the pages about Christ. Kizito was one of them. Having discovered this secret teaching, King Mwanga became fiercely hostile to Christians and had Joseph Mukassa burned alive in 1886. After his death many catechumens, including Kizito asked for baptism. The young Kizito only wanted to be like Christ.

On June 03, 1886 the king ordered him to be burned alive with other Christians. Kizito was 13. Before disappearing in the flames, he recited the Our Father, echoed by others sentenced to die in the fire. 'Goodbye my friends, we are on the right path,' were his last words. After his martyrdom, hundreds of people have asked to be baptized.




