## Saint Cecilia



Cecilia was likely martyred by cuts to her neck after attempts to steam her to death were unsuccessful. She was then buried in a loculus near the papal crypt in the Catacombs of Saint Callixtus. After being the object of devotion in the catacombs for centuries, Cecilia's remains were transferred by the Pope in the early 800s to her own Basilica in the Trastevere neighborhood of Rome. During some restoration work on the Basilica in 1599, Cecilia's body was uncovered and found to be incorrupt.

The marble is white, reflecting Cecilia's purity. The saint's face and hair are mysteriously covered by a sheet, inviting the mind to wonder. Cecilia's fingers seem to form a cryptic Christian symbol of the Trinity—Three in One.

## Christ the King

St. Ignatius of Loyola invites us to consider our relationship with Christ the King. As a knight, the image of a king was easily imagined for Ignatius.

Most of us presently struggle to imagine the reign of an earthly king. For the early Christians, kingship or sovereignty was a description of the relationship between Jesus and those who follow Jesus.

Now we imagine Christ the King. Jesus clearly states his mission in the Sermon on the Mount. In light of that mission, we ask ourselves: What do I feel? Do I want to join Christ? Does it make me excited? Passionate? Scared? Afraid? Courageous? Hopeful? What things do I resist? How do I want to join? What ignites inside of me?
