



Have you asked yourself.....?

2.- Why does the desire for God beat in a man?

"God Himself, creating man in His image, inscribed in his heart the desire to see Him. Although man often ignores such a desire, God never ceases to draw him to Himself, so that he lives and finds in Him that fullness of truth and happiness to which he tirelessly aspires. Consequently, man, by nature and vocation, is an essentially religious being, capable of entering in communion with God. This intimate and vital relationship with God gives man his fundamental dignity."

Comment by Monsignor José Ignacio Munilla:

"In this second point, we start from a concession in which God, when He created man, has left inscribed in his soul, if you will allow me the expression, as a spiritual DNA. That spiritual DNA is the desire for fulfillment, the desire for infinity, a wish of God. It is inscribed in the heart of every man and every woman, of all times and all cultures.

Because only God is the one who can fully satisfy that desire for improvement, for fullness that the heart of man has, to which everything in this life falls short. Even things that we want, that it seems to us that if we had them, with that already we would be completely happy. It is not like that. The day we get them, they immediately outgrow us, and we keep looking for more and more and more, what's behind that? The desire of God, which God has left inscribed in the heart of man."

"Dios mismo, al crear al hombre a su propia imagen, inscribió en el corazón de éste el deseo de verlo. Eso está inscrito en el corazón de todo hombre y de toda mujer, de todos los tiempos y de todas las culturas. Porque solamente Dios es el que puede satisfacer plenamente ese deseo de superación, de plenitud que tiene el corazón del hombre, al que todo en esta vida se le queda corto, incluso cosas que deseamos, que nos parece que, si las tuviésemos, con eso ya seríamos plenamente felices... pues no es así. El día que las conseguimos se nos quedan pequeñas inmediatamente, y seguimos buscando más y más y más, ¿qué hay detrás de eso? el deseo de Dios, que Dios ha dejado inscrito en el corazón del hombre".

Saint Joseph Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The husband of Mary had a perfect spouse, untouched by original sin. He was also the foster father to a boy who was the Son of God and the Second Person of the

Holy Trinity. Yet Saint Joseph, the least perfect member of his household, was still the head of the family. Authority does not always flow from moral or intellectual superiority. Authority in the Church, in particular, is God given. Because God chooses a certain person to fulfill a task in His household of faith, that person acts with a divine mandate to teach, sanctify, and govern the people and things entrusted to him. Saint Joseph is a model for how God uses imperfect instruments to exercise His perfect will. God does not want robots, machines, or zombies to mindlessly implement His plan for mankind. The history of the Church is replete with imperfect tools who have caused scandal and division. Wayward leaders have cost the Church entire countries. Yet despite all these unworthy instruments in the hands of the Divine Master, truth and shelter and grace continue to be provided to those Baptized into the Church, the Master's family.

Saint Joseph, Patron of the Universal Church, guide all those under the care of their pastors to see not their imperfections but their God-given obligation to fulfill God's plan. May your humble and faithful service inspire all fathers to lead their flocks with tenderness, wisdom, and strength.




