Have you asked yourself.....?

3.- How can one know God with the sole light of reason?

"Starting from Creation, that is, from the world and from the human person, man, with reason alone, can with certainty know God as the origin and end of the universe and as the supreme good, truth and infinite beauty."

Comment by Monsignor José Ignacio Munilla:

"As you can see, the catechism makes a strong convincing affirmation, and that is to say that God has given us a reason, an ability to know the truth and that the supreme truth that is God can also be known by reason. It will not be possible to demonstrate experimentally to God. I mean through the experimental empirical method how a chemical formula is experienced. No, God is knowable because He is pure Spirit. But God has given us a reason that can reach the certainty that God exists. Note that the Holy Scripture itself affirms this in Rom 1:20, which says 'the invisible of God, His eternal power and His divinity are perceptible to the intelligence from the creation of the world through His works."

Comentario de Monseñor José Ignacio Munilla:

"Como veis el catecismo hace una afirmación fuerte contundente, y es decir que Dios nos ha dado una razón una capacidad de conocer la verdad y que la suma verdad que es Dios también puede ser conocido por la razón a Dios no se le podrá demostrar experimentalmente me refiero a través del método empírico experimental cómo se experimenta una fórmula química. No, Dios es cognoscible porque es Espíritu puro. Pero Dios nos ha dado una razón que tiene la capacidad de llegar a la certeza de que Dios existe. Fijaros que la propia sagrada Escritura afirma esto en Rm 1, 20 que dice "lo invisible de Dios, su poder eterno y su divinidad son perceptibles para la inteligencia a partir de la creación del mundo a través de sus obras"".

The flutter of a wing, a rustling in the air, a voice, and the future began to begin

The Feast of the Annunciation is the reason why we celebrate Christmas on December 25. Christmas comes exactly nine

months after the Archangel Gabriel invited the Virgin Mary to be the Mother of God, an event we commemorate on March 25. The dating of these Feast Days, although interesting, is of minor importance compared to their theological significance. It is fruitful to reflect upon the incarnation of Jesus Christ in the womb of the Virgin Mary as the antecedent to the explosion of joy, caroling, gift giving, eating, drinking, love and family unity that surrounds the birth of the Savior. Perhaps Mary had a sort of private and internal Christmas at the moment of the Annunciation. Maybe she felt the fullness of the world's Christmas joy inside of her own heart when she realized she had been chosen to be the Mother of God.

O Holy Virgin Mary, we ask your intercession to make us as generous as you in accepting the will of God in our lives, especially when that will is expressed in mysterious ways. May you be our example of a generous response to what God desires of us.
