Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº 10 What value do private revelations have?

While not belonging to the deposit of faith, private revelations may help a person to live the faith as long as they lead us to Christ. The Magisterium of the Church, which has the duty of evaluating such private revelations, cannot accept those which claim to surpass or correct that definitive Revelation which is Christ.

COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

A first affirmation is that they do not belong to the deposit of faith; that is, it cannot be put on the same level as that of public revelation, which is preached by the Church. In addition we have to fully adhere to the revelation if we do not want to reject the gift of faith. If someone said that they do not believe or that they are not sure, it could not be said that they are someone who is against the Catholic faith or that they are heretics. No such thing could be said. Therefore, they do not belong to the deposit of faith, which does not mean that the Church does not value them. Yes, He values them and the proof that He values them is that He subjects them to discernment because we know that in the history of the Church, many of those private revelations have been of great help to open up and discover, in more depth, what is public disclosure itself.

Aunque no pertenecen al depósito de la fe, las revelaciones privadas pueden ayudar a vivir la misma fe, si mantienen su íntima orientación a Cristo. El Magisterio de la Iglesia, al que corresponde el discernimiento de tales revelaciones, no puede aceptar, por tanto, aquellas "revelaciones" que pretendan superar o corregir la Revelación definitiva, que es Cristo".

COMENTARIO DE MONSEÑOR JOSÉ IGNACIO MUNILLA

Una primera afirmación: que no pertenecen al depósito de la fe; es decir, no se puede poner eso en el mismo nivel que el de la revelación pública, que es predicada por la Iglesia y que además tenemos que adherirnos plenamente a la revelación, si no queremos estar rechazando el don de la fe. Si alguien por lo tanto, dijese que no cree o que no tiene certeza de que sea cierto, unas revelaciones privadas, no podría decirse que sea alguien que está en contra de la fe católica o que sea un hereje. No cabría decir tal cosa. Por lo tanto, no pertenecen al depósito de la fe, lo cual no quiere decir, que la Iglesia no las valore. Sí, las valora y la prueba de que las valora es que las somete a discernimiento, porque conocemos que en la historia de la Iglesia, muchas de esas revelaciones privadas han sido de gran ayuda para abrirse y descubrir, en más profundidad, lo que es la propia revelación pública.

Saint Matthias the Apostle

The Twelve were deeply biblical, so Judas had to be replaced

It was fitting, then, when "The Twelve" were reduced to "The Eleven" after Judas' self murder, that the fullness of the biblical number had to be restored.

And this is where today's saint steps out from the shadows to play his role in Christian history. The first chapter of the Acts of the Apostles, the great history book of the early

Church, tells us that, after the Ascension, the eleven Apostles returned to Jerusalem. There, Peter "stood up among the believers" to tell them that someone who had "accompanied us during all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us... must become a witness with us to his resurrection." Two names were proposed to replace Judas: Matthias and Joseph called Barsabbas. Then the Eleven prayed to the Lord to show them the way. They cast lots. Matthias was chosen. An Apostle, for the first time, had a successor.

Saint Matthias, we beg your intercession from your powerful throne in the Heavenly Jerusalem, that you fortify all who govern your Church to emulate "The Twelve" in their wisdom, trust, prudence, and daring in leading and spreading the Faith.


