Election Debate from a Catholic Perspective

Wednesday, May 18 at 7:30 p.m.

Representatives from Ontario's major political parties will discuss important issues for the Catholic community.

The debate will be livestreamed on the Archdiocese of Toronto's YouTube channel and Facebook page, and it will also be broadcasted on Salt+Light TV.

This event builds on the archdiocese's 2019 Federal Election Debate from a Catholic Perspective, which was viewed by more than 12,000 people between the online and in-person audiences. It was also the top trending topic in Canada on Twitter that evening.

This evening will include Cardinal Collins sharing his thoughts on the election. We hope you will join many other Catholics in sharing your thoughts using the hashtag #CatholicVote2022.

Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº 11 Why and in what way is divine revelation transmitted?

God “desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth” (1 Timothy 2:4), that is, of Jesus Christ. For this reason, Christ must be proclaimed to all according to His own command, “Go forth and teach all nations” (Matthew 28:19). This was brought about by Apostolic Tradition.

COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

There is a universal salvific will of God. The heart of God fights and dreams for the salvation of all men. Imagine the suffering of the heart of God, of the heart of Christ, when souls are taken from him. There is a particularly moving Gospel passage. The prayer that takes place when Jesus, after the Last Supper, is praying to the Father before His passion, before going to Gethsemane. At that moment, Jesus prays to the Father for all the souls that have been entrusted to Him, so that none of the souls are lost. We see how a mother, fights for her children and is willing to give her life for each one of them.

Caught between two masters, the pope is crushed in a secular vice

A pope is only called the “First” once there’s a “Second.” In 533, a man named Mercurius succeeded today’s John as Bishop of Rome. Mercurius’ birth name was so overtly pagan—honoring the Roman God Mercury—that he chose to honor his martyred predecessor John by adopting his same name. Mercurius thus initiated the venerable tradition of a pope adopting a new name upon his election. At the same time he also retroactively turned Pope John into Pope John I.

Pope Saint John I, your fidelity to your vocation as Pope led to your death. You were faithful in the face of threats from civil power but did not bend to its will. May all popes look to your example for inspiration in leading the Church.
