Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº 12 What is Apostolic Tradition?

Apostolic Tradition is the transmission of the message of Christ, brought about from the very beginnings of Christianity by means of preaching, bearing witness, institutions, worship, and inspired writings. The apostles transmitted all they received from Christ and learned from the Holy Spirit to their successors, the bishops, and through them to all generations until the end of the world.

COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

Each one of us, with the gifts that God has given us (which certainly are all different), must put them at the service of evangelization, but only if one knows evangelization does not begin with us. We are inserting ourselves into a history of two thousand years of that transmission of the message of Christ. And something that will guarantee us to properly evangelize is that our actions are inserted in that Apostolic tradition of two thousand years. This point of the catechism is broken down in five terms, what has been communicated has been carried out. First, by preaching; second, by testimony; third, by the institutions; fourth, for worship; fifth for the inspired writings.

Y algo que nos va a garantizar que evangelizamos bien es que nuestra acción evangelizadora se inserta en esa tradición Apostólica de los dos mil años. Este punto del catecismo, ha como desmenuzado, en cinco términos, eso que durante dos mil años se ha ido comunicando, y dice, que esa transmisión del mensaje de Cristo se realiza: primero, por la predicación; segundo, por el testimonio; tercero, por las instituciones; cuarto, por el culto; quinto por los escritos inspirados.

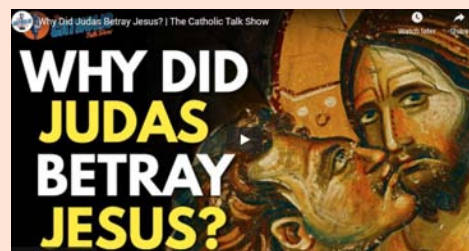
Emptiness, chaos, and guesswork about what frightening reality awaits behind the curtain.

He had departed but was fully alive. Christ showed that there was an alternative path, a different way to "do" leaving time and space.

Lord Jesus, You were from Mary biologically but from the Father theologically. On this Feast of the Ascension, You return to the Father's house. Help all who believe in You and who belong to You in the Church to one day join You in that heavenly home forever and ever.

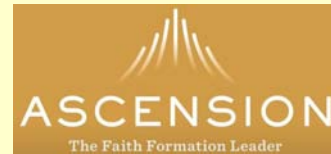
