## Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

Have you asked yourself.....?

#### Nº 13 In what ways does Apostolic Tradition occur?

Apostolic Tradition occurs in two ways: through the living transmission of the word of God (also simply called Tradition) and through Sacred Scripture which is the same proclamation of salvation in written form.

## COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

That Apostolic Tradition, of which we have spoken and has transmitted the message of Christ, in what way is it carried out; through what channels is it expressed? Dei Verbum, which is a dogmatic Constitution of the Second Vatican Council that dealt with this subject, formulated it in a very solemn way; saying that there are two sources from which we receive the revelation. These sources are: tradition, also called, the living transmission of the Word of God and Holy Scripture, which is having put the message of Jesus Christ in writing. This is an important matter, and it also distinguishes the Catholic conception from the Protestant one. Luther strongly reaffirmed that the only source is Scripture, saying that only Holy Scripture is the source of Revelation. This statement obviously has many derivations. When Luther affirms that only Holy Scripture is the source of tradition, we do not have the help of tradition to read it. This leaves us with a kind of free interpretation that allows for our own subjectivism.

#### Nº 13 ¿De qué modo se realiza la Tradición Apostólica?

La Tradición Apostólica se realiza de dos modos: con la transmisión viva de la Palabra de Dios (también llamada simplemente Tradición) y con la Sagrada Escritura, que es el mismo anuncio de la salvación puesto por escrito.

#### COMENTARIO DE MONSEÑOR JOSÉ IGNACIO MUNILLA

Esa Tradición Apostólica, de la que hemos hablado, que ha transmitido el mensaje de Cristo, ¿de qué modo se realiza? ¿por qué conductos se expresa? Dei Verbum, que es una Constitución dogmática del Concilio Vaticano II, que trató de ese tema, lo formuló de una manera muy solemne; diciendo que son dos fuentes desde las que recibimos la revelación. Estas fuentes son: la tradición, también llamada, la transmisión viva de la Palabra de Dios y la Sagrada Escritura, que es el haber puesto por escrito el mensaje de Jesucristo. Este es un tema importante, además que distingue la concepción católica de la protestante. Lutero reafirmó con mucha fuerza que, la única fuente es la Escritura, diciendo que solamente la Sagrada Escritura es la fuente de la Revelación. Esta afirmación, obviamente, tiene muchas derivaciones. Cuando Lutero afirma que solamente la Sagrada Escritura es la fuente de la tradición, uno se encuentra solo ante la lectura de la Sagrada Escritura y no tiene la ayuda de una tradición para leerla. Esto nos deja con una especie de interpretación libre de esa Sagrada Escritura y nos deja solos, a la voz de nuestro subjetivismo.
