MEMORANDUM

To: All Clergy, All Parishes, All Chancery
From: Fr. Edward J. Curtis, Vicar General
Date: May 31, 2022
Re: Sunday Mass Obligation

On March 13, 2020, Cardinal Collins issued a communication to the faithful of this archdiocese indicating that it was necessary to cancel public celebrations of the Eucharist on the coming Sunday, stating: "For this weekend and any other which may be required, I grant the faithful dispensation from their Sunday obligation".

Given that most of the health and safety restrictions in our parishes are no longer in place and the faithful are able to attend the celebration of the Eucharist once again, the basis for the dispensation from the Sunday obligation has dissipated and is no longer in effect.

The Church does not obligate people to do the impossible. If individuals, based on their conscience, cannot attend Mass for a grave reason, including a great vulnerability to COVID-19 or because they are self-isolating to limit the spread of illness, then they are excused from their Sunday obligation, as the law of the Church allows.

After two years of COVID-19 restrictions, many have been deprived of the opportunity to attend Mass and to receive the most Holy Eucharist and all of us have missed the opportunity to experience community, including members of our parishes. As we come to the celebration of Pentecost this weekend, we invite and encourage the faithful to return to the practice of attending Mass in-person.

Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº . What is the relationship between Tradition and Sacred Scripture?

Tradition and Sacred Scripture are bound closely together and communicate with one another. Each of them makes present and fruitful the mystery of Christ in the Church. They flow out of the same divine well-spring and together make up one sacred deposit of faith from which the Church emanates its certainty about revelation.

COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

In the previous point we recap that Apostolic Traditions are carried out in two ways, or that the Revelation of God is received through two sources: tradition (also called the living transmission of the Word) and Sacred Scripture. Now this question is; what is the relationship between the two? It is clearly underlined that the two are intimately linked. It would be absurd to think that the Catholic faith is divided between Sacred Scripture and living Tradition. That would be a misconception. Both Tradition and Holy Scripture illuminate each other. We begin by saying that Sacred Scripture bears witness to the existence of oral Tradition. For example, in a text, Saint Paul says: "I have received a tradition that I in turn transmit to you, that on the night that Jesus was going to be handed over, He took bread and said..." Then, Sacred Scripture gives an account of the existence of that tradition and says "...do this in memory of me". Many texts of Holy Scripture refer to this tradition. For example, another text from Corinthians says: "I remind you, brothers, of the Gospel that I preached to you, and in which you have remained faithful, by which you have been saved, if you keep it just as I preached it to you."

¿Te has preguntado.....?

Nº 14 ¿Qué relación existe entre Tradición y Sagrada Escritura?

La Tradición y la Sagrada Escritura están íntimamente unidas y compenetradas entre sí. En efecto, ambas hacen presente y fecundo en la Iglesia el Misterio de Cristo, y surgen de la misma fuente divina: constituyen un solo sagrado depósito de la fe, del cual la Iglesia saca su propia certeza sobre todas las cosas reveladas.

COMENTARIO DE MONSEÑOR JOSÉ IGNACIO MUNILLA

En el punto anterior habéis recordado que las Tradiciones Apostólicas se realizan de dos modos, o que la Revelación de Dios la recibimos a través de dos fuentes: la tradición (que también se llama la transmisión viva de la Palabra) y la Sagrada Escritura. Ahora esta pregunta dice ¿qué relación existe entre las dos? Lo que se subraya con claridad es que las dos están íntimamente unidas. Sería absurdo pensar que la fe Católica esta dividida entre la Sagrada Escritura y la Tradición viva. Eso sería una equivocada concepción; ambas, Tradición y Sagrada Escritura se iluminan mutuamente.

Comenzamos diciendo que la Sagrada Escritura da testimonio de que existe la Tradición oral. Por ejemplo, en un texto, San Pablo dice: "Yo he recibido una tradición que a su vez os transmito, que la noche en la que Jesús iba a ser entregado, tomó pan y dijo..." Luego, la Sagrada Escritura da cuenta de la existencia de esa tradición y dice "...haced esto en memoria mía". Muchos textos de la Sagrada Escritura hacen referencia a esta tradición. Por ejemplo, otro texto de Corintios dice: "Os recuerdo hermanos, el Evangelio que os prediqué, y en el cual habéis permanecido fiel, por el cual habéis sido salvados, si lo guardáis tal y como yo os lo prediqué"

One Mother, two motherhoods

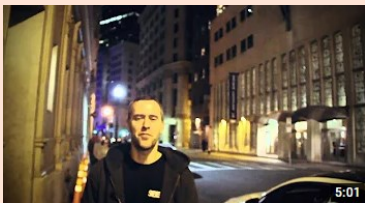

... and, although we can know a lot about Him, it's impossible to have a *relationship* with a concept. For example, we can't share our hearts with the law of gravity.

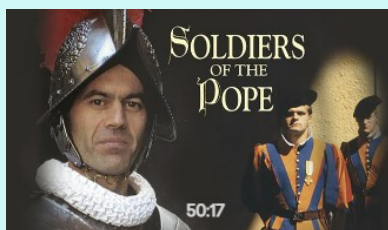
The Pythagorean theorem doesn't care about our worries and fears.

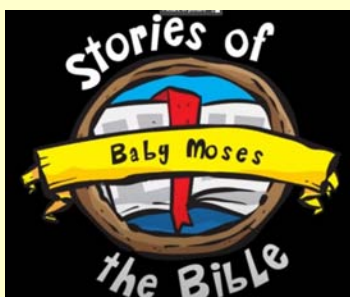
