Ukrainian Orphaned Babies in Need Can you help, again?

blessing, since the older Ukrainian community, who would normally supply blankets for these babies, are now busy working on camouflage blankets for the soldiers. The shipment of our numerous gifts are on their way to Ukraine as we speak, and the cost of the shipment was in access of \$3,500 – we extend a special thanks to all those who gave monetary donations for the shipping costs. But there is still a great need for our orphans and their caregivers.

We are humbly asking for your help once again. Supplies are running low, and there is a great need of all kinds of baby food, baby cereal, baby food pouches. We realize that baby formula is in short supply, but this should not stop us from doing what we can. They are also running low on diapers, feminine hygiene products and Power/Energy Bars (which are used to feed the many volunteers who work long hours and have no time to cook for themselves). Monetary donations are once again greatly appreciated to offset the shipping costs.

We are asking that all donations be received by the weekend of July 9/10. Your donations can be dropped off at the church office during office hours or in the sacristy after any of our Sunday Masses. Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº 15 To whom is the deposit of faith entrusted?

The Apostles entrusted the deposit of faith to the whole of the Church. Thanks to its supernatural sense of faith the people of God as a whole, assisted by the Holy Spirit and guided by the Magisterium of the Church, never ceases to welcome, to penetrate more deeply and to live more fully from the gift of divine revelation.

COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

The deposit of faith is where the teachings of the Lord are contained and also the very gift of His life. For example, the Eucharist, to whom has it been entrusted? Has it been entrusted to someone who has a certain profession in the life of the Church, to those who have a certain state of life? No, it has been entrusted to the whole Church. We have all received that great commendation, as when a father of a family gathers his family around his deathbed and communicates to them the last wills; so also the Lord, at the moment when He departed from this life, when He was pierced with a spear and blood and water gushed from His side, He was communicating to us what He had in His heart. We all, therefore, have the co-responsibility to welcome the deposit of faith. Perhaps this is especially important to underline in our day, because sometimes the laity, or many sectors of the life of the Church are not aware of having received the task of taking care of the deposit of faith.
