Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº 16 To whom is given the task of authentically interpreting the deposit of faith?

The task of giving an authentic interpretation of the deposit of faith has only been entrusted to the living teaching office of the Church, meaning, to the successor of Peter, the Bishop of Rome, and to the bishops in communion with him. To this Magisterium, which in the service of the Word of God enjoys a certain charism of truth, belongs the task of defining dogmas which are formulations of the truths contained in the divine Revelation. This authority of the Magisterium also extends to those truths necessarily connected with the Revelation.

COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

As the previous question stated, to whom has the deposit of faith been entrusted? and we answered that the deposit of faith has been entrusted to all of us and we all have to welcome, to learn, to transmit, and to live that deposit. But now, the question is different: who is to authentically interpret that deposit? And, although we all have a great responsibility, the Lord has given the Magisterial authority to the Pope, to the successor of Saint Peter and to all the bishops in communion with him. This is the living magisterium and it is the highest authority that the Lord has granted for the authentic interpretation of that deposit of faith.

Y, aunque todos tenemos una gran responsabilidad, sin embargo, la autoridad Magisterial se la ha entregado el Señor al Papa, al sucesor de San Pedro y al conjunto de los obispos en comunión con él. Este es el magisterio vivo y es la máxima autoridad que el Señor ha concedido para la interpretación auténtica de ese depósito de la fe.

Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Behold the heart which drips red for love of man

The widely loved devotion to the Sacred Heart is not rooted in a feast of ancient pedigree similar to those

of Holy Week. No Christian of the first millennium ever gazed into the haunting eyes of Christ as He stared out from a Sacred Heart image enthroned on the family-room wall. It was only in 1856 that Pope Pius IX placed this feast on the Church's universal calendar. The Pope acted after almost two centuries of devotion to the Sacred Heart, which had grown out of the thinking, preaching, and prayer of the indefatigable Saint John Eudes and out of the visions of Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. Both of these saints were indebted, in turn, to the medieval revelations of the Sacred Heart granted to Saint Gertrude the Great.

Sacred Heart of Jesus, You told us to ask and we shall receive, to seek and we shall find, to knock and the door shall be opened. Today, we ask, we seek, and we knock, in the sure and certain hope that you will hear us and answer us. Amen
