#### **Parking Lot Resurfacing**

Starting July 4<sup>th</sup>, and lasting for most of the months of July and August, we will be paving our Parking Lot. We will be closing down the parking lot and there will be limited parking at designated areas during the whole project. This means that there will be very limited parking. We will try to reserve these spots for parishioners who have mobility issues. However, we have been given permission to use Cardinal Leger High School parking lot during this construction period. Cardinal Leger's parking lot is only about 200 yards away from the church (i.e. this is a simple 3 Iron for golfers). We are asking parishioners who do not have mobility issues to park at the High School for Sunday Masses while the parking lot is being paved. Since most people will need to walk a longer distance to get to mass, we can call these next weekends in July and August "Walk to Sunday Mass Weekends". We thank you for your understanding and patience during this construction project.

# Ukrainian Orphaned Babies in Need Can you help, again?

Weeks ago, many of you stepped up with great kindness and generosity to help our orphaned children from Ukraine. The baby blankets that parishioners worked so hard on became a blessing, since the older Ukrainian community, who would



normally supply blankets for these babies, are now busy working on camouflage blankets for the soldiers. The shipment of our numerous gifts are on their way to Ukraine as we speak, and the cost of the shipment was in access of \$3,500 – we extend a special thanks to all those who gave monetary donations for the shipping costs. But there is still a great need for our orphans and their caregivers.

We are humbly asking for your help once again. Supplies are running low, and there is a great need of all kinds of baby food, baby cereal, baby food pouches. We realize that baby formula is in short supply, but this should not stop us from doing what we can. They are also running low on diapers, feminine hygiene products and Power/Energy Bars (which are used to feed the many volunteers who work long hours and have no time to cook for themselves). Monetary donations are once again greatly appreciated to offset the shipping costs.

We are asking that all donations be received by the weekend of July 9/10. Your donations can be dropped off at the church office during office hours or in the sacristy after any of our Sunday Masses. Monetary donations can be received as cash, or cheque – cheques can be made out to "Irene Galadza", wife of Fr. Roman Galadza, Pastor at St. Elias Ukrainian Church.

## Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº 17 What is the relationship between Scripture, Tradition and the Magisterium?

Scripture, Tradition and the Magisterium are so closely intertwined that none of them exists without the others. Together, under the action of the Holy Spirit, they contribute effectively and in their own way to the salvation of men.

## COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

Remember we said that Tradition and Scripture are like the two channels through which the source of revelation arrives. The Revelation is one, but it comes to us complementarily through two channels, Tradition and Scripture. In reality they are only one, the living word that is transmitted and that at certain moments was put in writing. It is important to understand that the People of God receive Tradition and Scripture in prayer and in the sacraments. We receive it in the apostolic doctrine that we are called to preserve, practice and profess. To preserve it, but not only as if it was a museum because sometimes for some, being faithful could seem like keeping something old, like putting a relic in a safe place in a museum, but, no, no, practice, not just preserve. Practicing and professing before the world, this is how Tradition has to be accepted, not as something that is archaeological from the past, but something that we practice and that we profess before the world, always proclaiming it as new.

#### Nº 17 ¿Qué relación existe entre Escrituras, Tradición y Magisterio?



#### COMENTARIO DE MONSEÑOR JOSÉ IGNACIO MUNILLA

La revelación es una, pero nos llega complementariamente por dos canales, Tradición y Escritura; que en realidad son una sola cosa, la palabra viva que se transmite y que en momentos determinados se puso por escrito. La recibe en esa acogida de la doctrina apostólica y que estamos llamados a conservar, practicar y profesar. Conservar, pero no sólo como si fuese un museo, porque hay cosas que se conservan en el museo. A veces para algunos, ser fieles a la fe, podría parecer como quién está guardando algo antiguo, lo está poniendo a buen recaudo en un museo, no, no, practicar, no sólo conservar. Practicar y profesar delante del mundo, así tiene que ser acogida la Tradición, no como algo que es arqueológico del pasado sino algo que practicamos y que profesamos ante el mundo, proclamándolo siempre como nuevo.

#### Saints Peter and Paul

Like the sun, Peter and Paul rose in the East but set in the West

In Matthew's Gospel, Christ states in unmistakably clear language that He will build His Church on Saint Peter (Mt 16:17–19). This was not a claim

from Peter but a statement of fact from Christ. For many centuries, this text has been cited in support of both Roman primacy and papal infallibility. Yet an even more fundamental historical, not biblical, fact originally supported Roman primacy. The great Saint Irenaeus in the late second century clarifies that Rome is "the greatest and most ancient Church, founded by the two glorious Apostles, Peter and Paul." No other city could claim to be the seat of two martyred Apostles. Not Jerusalem, not Antioch, and not Alexandria. Even Constantinople, the "New Rome," could not claim to have been built over the bones of even one Apostle. Rome's headship over all the churches is rooted most deeply in the martyrdoms in the eternal city of Saints Peter and Paul, the Christian counterparts of Rome's twin pagan founders Romulus and Remus.

## Should you bow or look up at the elevation at Mass?



After the elevation of the host and chalice were introduced into the Mass in the 13th century, one of the most common responses of the people was to **bow their heads in reverence.** It was an action to recognize the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, acknowledging the arrival of the King of kings.

In the 16th century this gesture was prescribed by various councils, and became a standard response.

However, St. Pius X suggested a different response, encouraging the faithful to look up and adore the Eucharistic host or chalice.
