



Pope Francis saddened by Fourth of July shooting in Chicago

Pope Francis has decried the tragic shootings that killed six and wounded some 30 others during a Fourth of July parade in the Chicago suburb of Highland Park on Monday, appealing for a rejection of all forms of violence, and a respect for life at all its stages.

The Holy Father did so in a telegram sent to the Archbishop of Chicago, Cardinal Blase Cupich. In the telegram, sent on the Pope's behalf by Vatican Secretary of State, Cardinal Pietro Parolin, he said he was "deeply saddened" to learn "of the senseless shooting" that took place in the US, and asked the Cardinal to convey his spiritual closeness to all affected by this attack.

Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº 19 How should Holy Scripture be read?

Sacred Scripture must be read and interpreted with the help of the Holy Spirit and under the guidance of the Magisterium of the Church, according to three criteria:

- 1) Paying attention to the content and unity of the entire Writing.
- 2) Reading of Scripture in the living Tradition of the Church.
- 3) Respect for the analogy of faith, that is, for the cohesion between the truths of faith.

COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

With the help of the Holy Spirit, the same Holy Spirit that has inspired the sacred authors, so that without error, they have captured those sacred pages that we are going to read. We ask that same Holy Spirit to help us read it properly. The Holy Spirit assisted the one who inspired that word, but the Holy Spirit also inspires the reader on a different level.

It is usually something very beautiful, entrusting ourselves and invoking our Mother, the Virgin Mary, before reading the Holy Scripture. Entrust yourself to her who accepted the Word of God in full docility. Just as when we go to confession, in the tradition of Spain, Mary is usually invoked - Ave María Purísima! It would also be good to invoke - Mary Ave Virgo audiens! Bird hearer of the Word enable us to read properly the Sacred Scripture under the action of the Holy Spirit.

The first condition to properly read Sacred Scripture: invoke the Holy Spirit and ask for inspiration through the intercession of Mary.

St. Mary Magdalene

An Apostle to the Apostles First spreads the Good News

Saint Mary Magdalene was among that troop of women who congregated on the outer edge of the twelve Apostles. These were probably

women of means, who "provided for" Jesus and the Apostles "out of their resources" (Lk 8:3). When these women are named, Mary Magdalene is always named first, similar to Saint Peter's position in the listing of the Apostles. Mary Magdalene is named many more times in the Gospels than most of the Apostles themselves, signaling her importance. The Gospel of Luke relates that seven demons were driven from her (Lk. 8: 2)

Saint Mary Magdalene, assist all who seek your intercession to be humble followers of Christ, doing, from the margins, what is necessary to carry forward the ministry of Christ's Church, quietly accomplishing God's will without recognition except for its eternal reward.




