



Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº 20 What is the canon of Scripture?

The canon of the Scriptures is the complete list of all the writings that the Apostolic Tradition has made the Church discern as sacred. Such a canon comprises forty-six writings of the Old Testament and twenty-seven of the New.

COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

We are asked the question: What is the canon of Scripture? The canon expression will seem strange to many, to some it will sound like a printer. So the question is where does the word canon come from? I think it is good that we make this reflection. Etymologically, the word canon comes from cane, reed, which was a kind of measuring stick, measuring stick as a criterion of truth; that is where the expression was formulated: "the Canon of the sacred books". The Church was discerning which books were the Word of God and recognized as inspired by the Holy Spirit and which ones were not. Already in the Old Testament, the Jewish people, without ever having used the word canon, made this discernment of which of the books they read were inspired by the Holy Spirit and could be considered as the Word of God and which were not. It was especially in the year 70, when the temple of Jerusalem was being destroyed, the moment in which the Jewish world definitively made that classification. The temple in Jerusalem had been destroyed, a diaspora came and the Jewish world needed to have that discernment, so when dispersed throughout the world, the Jews would be aware of what that canon was.



COMENTARIO DE MONSEÑOR JOSÉ IGNACIO MUNILLA

Se nos plantea la pregunta ¿Qué es el canon de la Escritura? La expresión canon a muchos les parecerá rara, a algunos les sonará una impresora, quizás. Entonces, la pregunta es ¿de dónde viene la palabra canon? creo que es bueno que hagamos esta reflexión, de hecho, a ello contesta el nº 20. Etimológicamente la palabra canon viene de caña, de junco, que era una especie de vara de medir, vara de medir como un criterio de la verdad; de ahí es de dónde se formuló esa expresión: "el Canon de los libros sagrados". La Iglesia fue discerniendo qué libros eran Palabra de Dios y eran reconocidos como inspirados por el Espíritu Santo y cuáles no. Ya en el Antiguo Testamento, el pueblo judío, sin haber utilizado nunca la palabra canon, hicieron ese discernimiento, de cuáles de los libros que se leían eran inspirados por el Espíritu Santo y podían ser considerados como Palabra de Dios y cuáles no. Fue especialmente en el año 70, cuando se estaba destruyendo el templo de Jerusalén, el momento en el que el mundo judío hizo definitivamente esa clasificación: de qué textos del Antiguo Testamento consideraban Palabra de Dios. El templo de Jerusalén había sido destruido, vino una diáspora y el mundo judío necesitaba tener ese discernimiento, para que, al dispersarse por el mundo entero, los judíos tuviesen conciencia de cuál era ese canon.
