St. Elias Ukrainian Parish, is once again deeply touched by the outpour of support for the many donations of baby items and adult needs. These items are now on route and should arrive in Ukraine any day now. The monetary donations people have given have covered the cost of shipping these items. Your willingness to support the suffering and needy is a beautiful testament to our Catholic Faith.

Ukrainian refugees are now arriving in Canada and there is a great need for our support with prayers and any other means to help them start their new lives here. They require employment opportunities, housing, furniture, kitchen items, and linens. These people are vetted and qualified to work. They can rent a basement apartment if available.

A parishioner of St. Mary's is housing 2 families and is requesting the following items; 2 adult bikes, 2 helmets for women and employment for the 2 women (one is an ESL teacher and the other is experienced in retail). Also, a 14-year-old female is available for babysitting and a 16-year-old male is looking for part-time work. Toys for 4 and 8-year-old boys are required as well.

Please spread the word to family and friends. Let us continue to pray for our brothers and sisters who are being affected by the war in Ukraine.

Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

Have you asked yourself.....?

Nº 21 What is the importance of the Old Testament for Christians?

Christians venerate the Old Testament as the true Word of God: all its books are divinely inspired and retain permanent value, bear witness to the divine pedagogy of God's saving love, and were written above all to prepare the coming of Christ the Savior of the world.

COMMENT BY MONSIGNOR JOSE IGNACIO MUNILLA

We receive the Old Testament as the Word of God. It is not that the Old Testament is less than the New Testament, but God showed the Revelation little by little and the fullness of the Revelation took place in Jesus Christ. Although the first books were also inspired, in them God had the patience to conform to the category of men who still needed much purification in order to receive the fullness of the Revelation of Jesus Christ.

There was a 'growing', therefore, the entire Old Testament has to be interpreted from the fullness to which it is directed. That is to say, the Revelation had been addressed to people that had a very limited degree of primitive culture, very notorious and had to gradually purify themselves until Jesus arrived and said: "Whoever hits you on the cheek, offer them the other also." So that Jesus could also say "Love your enemies... Do not return evil with evil... Do not confront those who offend you". In the Old Testament it was necessary to say "An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth". The Law of Talion was a way to put a containment on that carnal and savage tendency of men to have a kind of revenge without limit. The "eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth" was to set a limit, but that was clearly overcome by Jesus Christ

Nº 21 ¿Qué importancia tiene el Antiguo Testamento para los Cristianos?

Los Cristianos veneran el Antiguo Testamento como verdadera Palabra de Dios: todos Sus libros están divinamente inspirados y conservan un valor permanente, dan testimonio de la pedagogía divina del amor salvífico de Dios, y han sido escritos sobre todo para preparar la venida de Cristo Salvador del mundo.

COMENTARIO DE MONSEÑOR JOSÉ IGNACIO MUNILLA

Nosotros recibimos el Antiguo testamento como Palabra de Dios. No es que el Antiguo Testamento sea menos que el Nuevo Testamento, pero Dios fue mostrando la Revelación poco a poco y la plenitud de la Revelación tuvo lugar en Jesucristo. Aunque los primeros libros fueron también inspirados, en ellos Dios tubo paciencia de amoldarse a la categoría de hombres que todavía necesitaban mucha purificación para poder recibir la plenitud de la Revelación de Jesucristo. Hubo un 'ir creciendo', por eso, todo el Antiguo Testamento tiene que ser interpretado desde la plenitud a la que se dirige. Es decir, la Revelación se ha dirigido a un pueblo que tenía un grado de cultura primitiva muy salvaje, muy notoria y tenía que irse poco a poco purificando hasta que llegase Jesús y dijese: "Al que te pega en una mejilla, pónle la otra". Para que Jesús pudiese decir "Amad a vuestros enemigos... No devolváis al mal con mal... No hagáis frente al que os agravia", en el Antiguo Testamento hubo que decir aquello de "Ojo por ojo y diente por diente". La Ley del Tali6n era una manera de poner un dique de contenci6n a esa tendencia carnal y salvaje del hombre de tener una especie de venganza sin l6mite. El "Ojo por ojo y diente por diente" era poner un l6mite, pero eso fue superado claramente por Jesucristo.

The Assumption of Mary into heaven is a logical consequence of the dogma of the Immaculate Conception.
