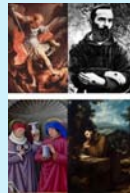

St. Pio of Pietrelcina (Padre Pio), Priest

Patron Saint of civil defense volunteers and adolescents

A humble friar's love for Christ burns holes through the palms of his hands

Padre Pio grew up dirt poor and uneducated in a village near Naples, Italy, in 1887. Neither his parents nor his grandparents could read or write. He was baptized as Francesco and helped on the family's small plot of land as a boy. The family was deeply religious, in the good, medieval way that perdured in rural, southern Europe far longer than it did in northern lands. Saints, feast days, devotions, processions, fasts, the Mass, angels, saints, the Virgin, and God saturated the atmosphere of Pietrelcina. Little Francesco and his family breathed Catholic air. It entered their bloodstream, circulated in their veins, and oozed out of every corpuscule. When he was about ten years old, Francesco decided to dedicate his life to God as a Franciscan friar.

Saint Pio, your intense love of God was communicated to the faithful in your celebration of Mass, your wise counsel in the confessional, and in your mystical experiences. What was so manifest in you was rare, but lies latent in every priest. Help every priest to be an icon of Christ.

COMPENDIO DEL CATECISMO DE LA IGLESIA CATÓLICA

Nº 24 ¿Qué función tiene la Sagrada Escritura en la vida de la Iglesia?

La Sagrada Escritura proporciona apoyo y vigor a la vida de la Iglesia. Para sus hijos, es firmeza de la fe, alimento y manantial de vida espiritual. Es el alma de la teología y de la predicación pastoral. Dice el Salmista: "lámpara es tu palabra para mis pasos, luz en mi sendero" (Sal 119, 105). Por esto la Iglesia exhorta a la lectura frecuente de la Sagrada Escritura, pues "desconocer la Escritura es desconocer a Cristo" (San Jerónimo).

Monseñor José Ignacio Munilla

Es una cita muy fuerte con la que termina: "Desconocer la Escritura es desconocer a Cristo". Hay citas muy similares, de los santos que han tenido una relación profunda con Jesucristo, y valoran la Sagrada Escritura como un elemento determinante de esa relación tan profunda; por ejemplo: San Agustín dice que, "el Evangelio es la boca de Jesucristo", ¡qué hermosa expresión! San Francisco de Asís dice: "leer la Escritura es pedir consejo a Jesucristo", esta Escritura es la boca de Jesucristo, desde ella me va a hablar. San Francisco de Asís hablaba de la importancia de acoger el Evangelio, sin glosa. Hay que entender esta expresión, porque no es verdad que la Sagrada Escritura tenga que ser leída en un sentido literalista, fundamentalista. Por ejemplo, si un día vemos en el Evangelio: "Y si tu ojo derecho te hace caer, sácatelo... o si tu mano te hace caer, córtatela". Obviamente, no tenemos que interpretar ese texto evangelico en un sentido literal fundamentalista.
