

Even using the name "God" or "Father" or "Jesus Christ" presupposes the mediation of language. So although someone may say they want to "cut out the middle man" of the Church and go directly to God, they can't. At some point in their youth they absorbed who God was from others, so even the most basic, apparently innate knowledge we have of God is mediated, even if only by nature itself. Today's feast is about the created spiritual beings known as angels who fill the space between God and man, communicating His message, protecting man from harm, and battling against the armies of Satan. The Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael transmit some of God's most important messages.


