Indigenous Reconciliation Fund Hits First Target



The \$30 million Indigenous Reconciliation Fund has achieved its first-year goal raising \$9.4 million and the fund's board has greenlit 17 projects.

The Archdiocese of Toronto has so far raised just under \$1 million of the \$6 million it has pledge to the fund. The money comes from annual fall collections, but any shortfall in fundraising will be covered by archdiocesan assets and budgets.
