Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Behold the heart which drips red for love of man

Christ's Sacred Heart teaches us that God loves us as a friend loves a friend, as a parent loves a child, or as a sibling loves his closest brother or sister. That is, Christ loves us in the same way as a person loves us, only

more intensely.

Understanding God's love should be as simple as recalling your little hand in your father's big hand as you walked next to him at night as a little girl. 
Solanus and the Bees
