Feast of St. Mary Magdalene (July 22)

Saint Mary Magdalene, also known as Magdalene or Mary of Magdala, is most likely named after the bustling fishing village of Magdala on the western edge of the Sea of Galilee. All information about Mary comes from the Gospels.

<u>Luke 8:1–3</u> introduces her as one of the many women who accompanied Jesus and the Twelve, providing for them out of their own resources. These women are said to have been "cured of evil spirits and infirmities," and Mary is specifically noted to have been delivered from "seven demons."

Saint Mary Magdalene, you lived a sinful life, but when you encountered Jesus, you repented and followed Him. You were faithful to Him throughout His ministry and were a witness to His death and Resurrection. Please pray for me, that I may always have the courage to repent of my sins and stand with you at the foot of the Cross so that I may also be a witness to the transforming effects of the Resurrection. Saint Mary Magdalene, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You.
