Religious Education and Faith Formation



St. Elizabeth of Hungary (Nov 17)

Elizabeth was born to King Andrew II and Queen Gertrude of Hungary. Her aunt on her mother's side was Saint Hedwig, Duchess of Silesia. From the very beginning, Elizabeth did not fit in with the courtly life.

She was sensitive to the poor, sought virtue, and preferred simplicity, which made her an object of gossip and slander among the more "refined" members of the court. When Elizabeth was sixteen, Franciscan friars arrived at the castle to care for the spiritual needs of the royal court. The holy Friar Conrad of Marburg became Elizabeth's spiritual director. Through him, she learned about the saintly life of Saint Francis who probed the highest heights of holiness, even being pierced with the stigmata at the end of his life by a Seraphim, the highest of the choirs of angels, earning him the revered title "the Seraphic Father." Stories of Saint Francis, the influence of the friars, and her own devotional life drew her deeper into the mysteries of faith.

Elizabeth's heart was inflamed with a desire for charity and justice. If she saw an injustice, she quickly sought to remedy it. Rather than eat food that was unjustly obtained, she preferred to go hungry. If the poor were cheated, she paid the debt owed them out of her own money.


