

3.Update your information by filling in the Information Card and your Sunday envelopes for each of the next three Sundays.

4. The number on the box you chose is your new number for the entire year and will be the number used to issue your tax receipt at the end of 2025.

5.<u>PLEASE</u> - destroy all envelopes from previous years. As of January 1st you won't be registered under any other number - only your new 2025 number.


