Ash Wednesday - March 5th Mass Schedule

Ashes will be distributed at all Masses: 7:30am, 9:00am, 12:00noon and 7:00pm This is a day of fasting and abstinence

During Lent, we will have *The Stations of the Cross* every Friday at 7:30 pm (after the 7:00 pm Mass)



A quick reminder of Days of Fast and Abstinence:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.



For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from eating meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Glorious Resurrection.


