

* Sundry Expenses Include: Parish Programs (Sacramental), Youth Activities, Faith Formation, Retreats & Seminars, Social Events, Flowers, Social Outreach, Legal Fees, DVD / CD / Media / Books, Candles & Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Expenses. An extra \$26,305 was disbursed to help the community in 2024 * Admin Expenses Include: Service Charges, Office Services, Office Supplies and Communications

* Chancery Investments: \$18,000 invested into the Parking Lot account / \$200,000 invested / \$11,819 interest reinvested

* Property Additions and Restorations: The last 10% of the New Boiler was paid at the beginning of 2024
