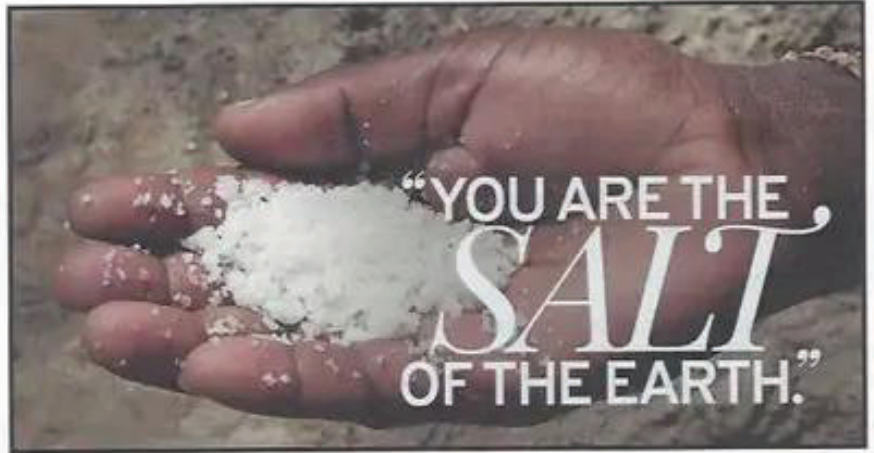

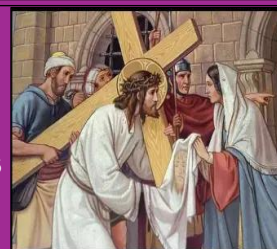
### Ash Wednesday February 18<sup>th</sup> Mass Schedule

### Mass with Anointing for the Sick

The Church observes the **World Day of the Sick on February 11<sup>th</sup>**, coinciding with the Feast of our Lady of Lourdes. To honour this observance, we will offer healing ministry by having a Mass with anointing **on Saturday, February 14<sup>th</sup> at 12:00pm**. This will be a special Mass at which those in need may receive the sacramental anointing for healing.

**Who should receive the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick?** Those who are elderly and whose frailty is becoming more pronounced. Those adults and children who are suffering from a major illness, are facing surgery, serious medical tests or have suffered a serious accident. Those who suffer from chronic illness such as arthritis or diabetes, or who suffer from serious mental illness.

### Bereavement Ministry Formation and Training

This online program is designed for new and seasoned parish bereavement ministers. Registrants are required to participate in all online sessions, complete pre-homework and pass final assessment. There is no cost to attend but register early as capacity is limited.
