A Different Approach to Fasting

Lenten fasts tend to be oriented towards things like giving up food and television. But there are many other creative ways we welcome Jesus' healing touch this Lent. Consider these:

- *Fasting from anger and hatred.* Give your family an extra dose of love.
- *Fasting from judging others.* Before making any judgements, recall how Jesus overlooks our faults.
- *Fast from discouragement.* Hold on to Jesus' promise that He has a plan for your life.
- *Fast from complaining.* When you are about to complain, close your eyes and recall some of the little moments of joy Jesus has given you.
- *Fast from resentment or bitterness.* Work on forgiving those who may have hurt you.
- *Fast from spending too much money.* Try to reduce your spending by 10% and give these savings to the poor.
